One word best describes Quebec City: Romantic. Old Quebec looks as if it has been transplanted from France and reassembled on the cliffs jutting into the St. Lawrence River. With its narrow, winding streets, ancient buildings and horse-drawn carriages, this city exudes more than four centuries of history and charm. No trip to the area is complete without seeing Montmorency Falls, and of course the spectacular international fireworks competition!

Day 1 Our tour arrives late afternoon in beautiful Quebec City for check-in at *Manoir Victoria* (800) 463-6283, located in the heart of historic, culturally vibrant, gastronomic and romantic Old Québec, the unique 4-star European-style hotel extends a warm and friendly welcome in an inviting decor and spectacular surroundings that have been delighting visitors for centuries. DINNER this evening will be in the heart of Place Royale Quebec, Les Voutes du Cavour built in the eighteenth century, a setting steeped in history.

Day 2 Enjoy BREAKFAST meet our guide and you will see Place d'armes, Latin Quarter, the Basilica, City Hall, Parliament, Plains of Abraham, the Citadel, Quartier petit Champlain en Place Royale. Spend time strolling through the streets of Vieux-Québec, you will be unable to resist handicraft stands, renowned fashion designer boutiques, art galleries and gourmet food stores. Return to the hotel and the evening is free for you to enjoy dinner on your own, and the amenities of your hotel, including the new spa du manoir, the indoor pool, sauna and fitness centre.

Day 3 BREAKFAST at your leisure and free time to explore Old Quebec on your own pace. Later today, **Les Grands Feux Loto!** Named the *Top Event in Canada*, it has mesmerized audiences with its dazzling pyrotechnic displays set against one of the world's most spectacular waterfalls, in Montmorency Falls Park. Pyrotechnic masters from five countries present pyro-musical shows that awe spectators through a display of dazzling colors and a choreography of forms that only master firework-makers of this caliber can produce. It truly holds a special place in the heart of all Quebecers.

Day 4 Today, after BREAKFAST we'll pack up our memories of the provincial capital and bid farewell to the Gaelic warmth of Canada's most charming city.
